Article 4 (Types of Scholarships) The types of scholarships for AIGS international students shall be as follows: 1. Tuition Scholarship: A scholarship paid to settle the admission fee and tuition. 2. General Living Scholarship: A scholarship paid to support the dormitory and meal expenses of international students. 3. Special Living Scholarship: A scholarship specially paid according to the intention of an external donor who wishes to support living expenses for international students. 4. <u>Work Scholarship: A scholarship paid to students who perform prescribed work at places designated on campus.</u> 5. Other Scholarships: Scholarships paid for other separate purposes.	Article 4 (Types of Scholarships) No change 1. – 3. No change. <u>4. AIGS diligently seeks many ways to provide grants and bursaries to all international students who are in need of financial aid. AIGS arranges the “ACTS Great Commission Scholarship” (AGCS) and also provides all enrolled international students with the ACTS Matching Fund (AMF), which covers most of the study expenses. To receive both the ACTS Grant as AGCS and the ACTS Scholarship as AMF, all enrolled international students must submit to the AIGS Office each semester, by March 31 and by September 30: (1) the scholarship application form; and (2) a copy of their current bank account book opened in Korea, showing (a) the first page with the student’s name and account information, and (b) the last page showing the student’s account balance. This portion of the scholarship is fully covered by ACTS and comprises the following:
